2 21-03-2022 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner
and the learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Rajapakar P.S. Case No. 128 of 2021, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 393, 413, 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-B)A, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged that unknown miscreants, who were riding on a motorcycle, had overtaken the vehicle of the informant and had stopped the same, whereafter they had tried to snatch the vehicle in question, however, on account of informant having raised alarm, passers-by had



arrived at the place of occurrence and the accused persons including the petitioner were arrested. As far as the petitioner is concerned, one knife and one mobile phone were recovered, upon search having been conducted.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent, he has been falsely implicated in the present case, he is having a clean antecedent and he is languishing in custody since 15.5.2021. The learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner has already been sufficiently punished on account of his incarceration.

Per contra, the learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into account the materials available on record as also considering the period of incarceration of the petitioner herein, apart from the fact that the petitioner is having a



clean antecedent, I deem it fit and proper to direct for release of the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-1st, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Rajapakar P.S. Case No. 128 of 2021.
