2 23-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 298 litres of liquor is said to have been recovered from a Hyundai Santro car and the petitioner was amongst the two persons arrested.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the petitioner's possession. He has no concern either with the seized liquor nor with the car in question. He is in custody since 5.7.2021 and has no criminal antecedent. Chargesheet has been submitted in the case.

Heard learned APP for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case together with the the petitioner being in custody for more than 7 months and not having any criminal antecedent, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Risiyap P.S. Case no. 53 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Aurangabad.
