3 30-11-2022 Though, the present writ petition was filed to remove the encroachment made over the Government land, situated south of the land of the petitioner appertaining to Mouza- Uprama, Thana no. 74, Khata no. 348, Khesra no. 183, Rakwa-7 decimals, however, the learned counsel for the respondent State, by referring to the counter affidavit filed in the present case, has submitted that the encroachment in question has already been removed, a fact which has not been disputed by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Nonetheless, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that debris is still lying at the place in question.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to dispose off the present writ petition, in as much as the grievances of the petitioner has stood redressed, however, with a direction to the District Magistrate, Banka to ensure removal of the debris within 48 hours.
