Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that till date, investigation in this case is pending.

A perusal of the First Information Report giving rise to the present case would show that there is an allegation against the petitioner that he was establishing physical relationship with the complainant right from her childhood age and he was regularly alluring her in the name of marriage.

In the kind of allegations made in the First



Information Report and as the investigation is still pending, this
Court finds no reason to interfere with the same.

The application is, thus, dismissed.
