2 13-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

It is a case of recovery of Nepali liquor from a vehicle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioner has not been made accused in this case whereas his name has only been dragged during investigation due to an Apache Motorcycle bearing Reg. NO. BR-32AD-7957 is in the name of this petitioner, which was seized by the informant with an allegation to carry 45 liters of Nepali liquor, whereas this petitioner is neither concern with the alleged apprehended accused or with the



occurrence. He further submits that petitioner is ready to deposit of Rs.20,000/- in the District Legal Services Authority, Madhubani. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani in connection with Ladania P.S. Case No. 184 of 2021/ G.R. No. 1061 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C with condition that at the time of furnishing bail bond, the petitioner shall produce the receipt of Rs.20,000/-.
