APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been  
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection  
with Shekhopur Sarai P.S. Case no. 72 of 2021 instituted for the  
offence under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B)/34 of  
the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioner along with his  
brother-in-law indulged in cheating the innocent people on the  
plea of bank loan, online shopping by using their mobiles.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner  
has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no  
offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. On mere



suspicion, petitioner has been dragged in the present case. He has got no criminal antecedent. The name of the petitioner has been disclosed in this case by the co-accused Sannat Kumar, who was apprehended on spot, which has got no evidentiary value in the eye of law.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Shekhopur Sarai P.S. Case no. 72 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Sheikhpura subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
