ORAL ORDER

2 29-11-2022 Petition for pre-arrest bail of petitioner no.3 is
dismissed as withdrawn.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners no. 1,2 and 4
and the State.

Petitioners no. 1, 2 and 4 apprehend their arrest in a
case registered for the offence punishable under Sections
307/379/34 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Accusation of assault is against other co-accused
persons and these petitioners are alleged to have snatched
golden chain and damaged house hold articles. Parties are
agnate and there is land dispute between them.

Considering the nature of allegation against the
petitioners no. 1, 2 and 4, in the event of arrest/surrender within



six weeks from today, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate I, Saran at Chapra in Taraiya Police Station Case No. 191 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under sections 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
