learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 504, 506

of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case as per F.I.R is that all the



accused persons including petitioners started abusing the informant and when he raised protest, all the accused persons started assaulting the informant and when other family members of the informant came to his rescue, they were also assaulted by the accused persons. In this occurrence informant sustained fracture in his hand and his sons and maternal son sustained injuries on their head by iron rod.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the present case. It is also submitted that both parties are agnates and in the background of some land dispute, the present F.I.R has been registered. There is counter version of the occurrence also and petitioners' side also received injuries. There is no accusation of repeating the blow.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of



four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Rajoun P.S. Case No. 230 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
