3 26-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of
non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will
place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 342,
323, 307, 498A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of D.P.
Act.

Petitioner, who is husband of opposite party no2., is
said to have ousted the opposite party no.2 from her
matrimonial home in association of his family members over the



dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that petitioner is the husband of the opposite party no. 2. He submits that there is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioner. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the informant received three injuries. Injury no. 1 is burn injury on left hand palm, injury no. 2 is burn injury on left abdomen and injury no. 3 is bruise on right check.

Considering the nature of allegation, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected in connection with Chakia P.S. Case No. 93 of 2020.
