2 14-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through virtual court proceedings.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

40 litres of country made Mahua liquor has been
recovered from the house of co-accused, Shravan Kumar. The
petitioner and other co-accused person fled away from the place of
occurrence after seeing the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. It is further submitted that petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail
application. It is also submitted that there is no recovery from the
conscious possession of the petitioner.

Petitioner is agree to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/-



(rupees ten thousand) in Bihar State Legal Services Authority bearing Account No.0380000100252472, IFSC Code: PUNB0038000, Punjab National Bank, Patna.

Taking into consideration the fact that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise Court, Second, Aurangabad in connection with Bandeya P.S. Case No.30 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the further conditions that:

(i) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.

(ii) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.
