Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



(i) For issuance of appropriate writ /writs, order/ orders, direction/ directions in the nature of mandamus commanding respondents concern to consider the representation made by the petitioner regarding settlement and restructure of loan amount which was taken by the petitioner for business in the name and style M/S Singh transport in which petitioner is proprietor.

(ii) For further directing the respondents concern for not taking adverse action against the property mortgaged by the petitioner.

(iii) For any other relief/ reliefs for which the petitioner is entitled to.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, before the appropriate forum, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any



opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with
the liberty aforesaid.

disposed of.
