ORAL ORDER

2 29-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within four weeks.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354, 379, 308, 504 & 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

While the daughter of the informant went to see her field, petitioner no.1 is said to have tried to outrage her modesty. Petitioner no.1 assaulted the husband of the informant on his head by iron rod and petitioner no.2 took out the ornament from



the possession of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that no such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is admitted land dispute between the parties. There is case and counter case between the parties. The injury sustained by the victim is simple in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Azamnagar (S) P.S. Case No.21 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
