The learned counsel for the respondent Patna Municipal Corporation submits that in case the show cause reply is filed by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, appropriate decision thereon shall be taken, in



accordance with law, within a period of four weeks, thereafter.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate show cause reply within a period of four weeks from today which shall be considered by the Executive Officer, New Capital Circle, Patna, in accordance with law and appropriate final order shall be passed thereon within a period of four weeks, thereafter.

It is needless to state that for a period of eight weeks from today status quo existing as on today shall be maintained.
