2 30-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in
a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
30(a), 34, 36 and 37(b)(c) of the Excise Act, 2018.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the allegation is
of recovery of 90 litres of liquor and 69.375 litres of liquor from
a Toyota car parked at Dhakanpura Babu Bazar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was
recovered from his conscious possession. It is next submitted
that name of the petitioner transpired in the confessional
statement of Amit Kumar. It is also submitted that petitioner has



no concern with the alleged vehicle and he came to be implicated merely because he has antecedent.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposes the anticipatory bail application.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Gardanibagh P. S. Case No.09 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The application stands allowed.
