At the outset, the learned counsel for the

petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner

to approach the Respondent No. 3, by filing

appropriate petition under the provisions of the



Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956
however, seeks a direction upon the Respondent
No. 3 to take appropriate action, in accordance
with law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

It is needless to state that in case,
appropriate petition is filed by the petitioner before
the Respondent No. 3 within a period of four weeks
from today, the Respondent No. 3 shall consider
the same and pass appropriate orders thereon, in
accordance with law, within a period of twelve
weeks, thereafter.
