ORAL ORDER

2 01-09-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within one month.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the learned APP for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 30 (C) of 2022, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 379, 504, 506 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the allegation, the accused persons tortured the complainant for non-fulfillment of dowry demand of rupees two lac



cash. The husband brought the complainant to her matrimonial house on 16.08.2019 but again she was tortured.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioners are the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the victim. They live separately from the husband of the complainant. They are the persons of clean antecedents.

Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Nasim Nazar, learned Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Begusarai in connection with Complaint Case No. 30 (C) of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioners within the stipulated time provided in para-1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
