2 13-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304(B) and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of dowry death due to non-fulfilment of dowry demand by in-laws of the deceased family.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioner is the villager of the husband of the deceased and he has no concern with the mess and business of the deceased and her husband, namely, Ranjit Kumar who is in judicial custody as stated in para-9 of the petition. Petitioner has clean antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Jehanabad in connection with Kako P.S. Case No. 47 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
