The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 1829 of 2016 registered for offences
under Sections 363, 366-A of the Indian Penal Code.

Section 164 of the Cr.P.C., this anticipatory bail application is
allowed.



Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VI, Katihar, in connection with Complaint Case No. 1829 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
