2 19-05-2022 After some arguments, the learned counsel for the

petitioner submits that since the order dated 07.08.2020, passed

by the learned S.D.M. Hilsa, District-Nalanda in Case

no. 48(M.P.)/2020/ Case no. 624(M)/2020, purportedly under



Section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure has since worked out its force, inasmuch as any order passed under Section 144 Cr.P.C. is valid only for a period of 60 days, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition, however with liberty to agitate his subsisting grievances, if any, by taking recourse to such remedies as are available under the law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed off as not pressed, however with the aforesaid liberty.
