2 11-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 53.525 litres of IMFL was recovered from the petitioner's house.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner or from his house. He has been falsely implicated in the case. He has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 6.8.2021.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case specially the petitioner not having any criminal antecedent, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Imamganj P.S. Case no.139 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge of Excise Act, Gaya.
