2 18-02-2022 Heard the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Baligaon P.S. Case No. 56 of 2020 instituted for the offences under Section 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel submits that the mother-in-law and son-in-law of the deceased have been granted anticipatory bail by the coordinate Bench. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners are elder brothers-in-law of the deceased and were living separately and this case is similar to that of son-in-law.

I have considered the submissions.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects, I am inclined to grant benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioners

and in the event of arrest they shall be released on bail subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
