Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504, 506, 325 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners are said to have assaulted the informant along with his family members by means of lathi, danda, iron rod, sharp weapon and pistol as a result of which informant's



side sustained head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute. He submits that there is case and counter case between the parties and both sides have sustained injury. He submits that the injury found upon the victim is simple in nature. He submits that there is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioners. He further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are six persons have got injured in this case and all of them have got almost one injury at their skull although the opinion of injuries have been kept reserved by the doctor.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in



connection with Udwant Nagar P.S. Case No. 193 of 2022,
subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of
the Cr.P.C.
