learned A.P.P. for the State.

Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposes
the bail application of the petitioner and submits that there
is no pleading in the anticipatory bail application that as to

Court seeking anticipatory bail.



Considering the submission made by the learned
A.P.P. for the State, the Court is not inclined to extend the
privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
