2 30-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30, 30(a) and 41 of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has antecedent of four cases and allegation is of recovery of 900 liters spirit from the bushes near co-accused Bhola Nut's house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, even the alleged recovery is from a place which is accessible to public at large and does not belong to the petitioner and he came to be



implicated based on his antecedents.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mashrak P.S. Case No. 181 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
