learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Sarairanjan P.S. Case No. 116 of 2019 registered under
Sections 392, 412 and 120B of the I.P.C.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is

that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case due to enmity and grudge. Petitioners have no concern with the alleged occurrence.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State opposed the prayer of the petitioners by contending that the petitioners have actively participated in the alleged occurrence. Further he submits that petitioners are accused in several criminal cases. Hence, the petitioners do not deserve to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the State, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, prayer of the petitioners is rejected.
