3 25-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Excise Case No. 94 of 2021 registered under Section 30(a)
of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case due to village enmity. Further
submission is that the alleged recovery has been made from the
joint family house of the petitioner, as is evident from the
supplementary affidavit. Petitioner has no criminal history.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Muzaffarpur in connection with Excise Case No. 94 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
