APP for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Rivilganj P.S. Case No.158 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 447, 341, 323, 504, 332, 333, 353, 307 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners along with other co-accused persons named in the FIR and 100 unknown entered into the police station and assaulted the police personnel. The accused persons damaged the vehicles standing in the premises of the police station.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this



case. It is further submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. As per the FIR, the petitioners are the members of the mob. The specific allegation is against co-accused, Pintu Singh. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail application.

The learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Taking into consideration the facts aforesaid, let petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran, Chapra in connection with Rivilganj P.S. Case No.158 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
