APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the
defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of four weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered
under Sections 376, 341, 323, 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of establishing physical
relationship with the informant on the pretext of marriage.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. On the pretext
of marriage, the petitioner is alleged to have established physical
relationship with the informant. The same was consensual
relationship between the parties. He has placed reliance of cases of



the Hon'ble Supreme Court since reported in 2019 SCC Online SC-3100 (*Dr. Dhruvaram Murlidhar Sonar versus The State of Maharashtra & Ors.*) and (2019) 9 SCC 608 (*Pramod Suryabhan Pawar vs. The State of Maharashtra and Ors.*)

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of Sri Abhishek Anand, learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Samastipur in connection with Women P.S. Case No. 42 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
