ORAL ORDER

2 18-08-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“(a) For issuance of writ in the matter of mandamus commanding respondent no.2 to 6 Respondent authorities to Adequate protection to vacate illegal encroachment and protection and security in construction and Extension is required of more than hundred years old mosque on its own land of than no. 62, Khata no. 772, cadastral survey plot no. 1098 at village Sagi Masjid, P.S. and circle Khodawandpur, District Begusarai after demolition of illegal Encroachment by some land grabbers and



miscreants of the locality Respondent authorities may be directed to vacate encroachment by applying armed forces applying armed forces and for the other necessary reliefs for which the petitioners are entitled for in accordance with law.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of the grievances of the petitioner. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
