Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 494/498(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner, who is mother-in-law of the informant is said to have ousted the informant from her matrimonial home in association of her family member over the dowry demand.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this



case. He submits that petitioner is the mother-in-law of the informant. He submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Paliganj P.S. Case No. 174 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
