ORAL ORDER

3 09-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under sections 8(c), 20(B)(ii) (c), 27(A) and 29 of the NDPS Act and sections 25(1-B)(a) and 26 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, 59 kgs of ganja, arms and ammunitions were recovered from the house of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the petitioner's possession or from his house. The house in question belongs to the joint family. The petitioner is in custody since 25.7.2021 and has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned APP for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the recovery of 59 kgs of ganja together with arms and ammunitions as detailed in the seizure list, the Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail and the application is rejected.

Learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
