ORAL ORDER**

removed within four weeks of starting of Court proceeding in

physical mode in normal course.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 363,366(A),504 and 506/34
of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he forcibly
took away the minor daughter of the informant namely, Saheli
Kumari with an intention to solemnize marriage with her.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner has clean antecedent. He has falsely been
implicated in the present case. He further submits that in fact



the victim was having love affair with the petitioner and she has solemnized the marriage with the petitioner on 14.01.2021. He further submits that the statement of the victim girl was also recorded under Section 164 Cr. P.C. on 08.04.2021 in which she categorically stated that she has solemnized marriage with the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 08.04.2021.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Sanhaura Police Station Case No.19 of 2021, with the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.



(3) One of the bailors must be the victim girl, namely, Saheli Kumari, Wife of Ranjit Kumar Mandal, D/o Umesh Prasad Mandal, R/o Village-Khiridar, P.S.- Sanhaura, District-Bhagalpur.

(4) And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
