APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Sasaram (Town) P.S. Case no. 799 of 2020 instituted for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 498A, 504 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioners along with their family members have tortured in various ways due to non-fulfillment dowry demand tot he informant.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-



law of the informant and have been falsely implicated in this case. They have never demanded any thing from the informant. They have no concern with the daily activity of the informant and her husband and are living separately. The sole responsibility to take care of wife is upon husband of the informant and not against his family members.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Sasaram (Town) P.S. Case no. 799 of 2020, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Rohtas at Sasaram subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
