A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 504, 494, 498A, 34 of the Indian Penal Code & Section 3 /4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and from perusal of the allegation as alleged in the F.I.R, it would manifest that the allegation of demand and torture is general and omnibus in nature as far as this petitioner is alleged, it is next submitted that the petitioner is brother-in-law of the informant. It is also submitted that whenever a dispute arises between the husband and wife, the entire family members are implicated.



Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 16 of 2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
