2 11-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a

case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 70 litres of country made

liquor and 4400 litres of fragmented solution from the

bank of river. The petitioner is alleged to have fled away

from the place of seizure.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the

petitioner that petitioner was not apprehended from the



spot. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern either with the seized illicit liquor or the place of seizure. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Excise Court No. 2, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Excise Complaint Case No. 556 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
