ORAL ORDER

2 24-02-2022 Heard both the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Parihar P.S. Case No.56 of 2021 instituted for the offences under Sections 447, 448, 341, 323, 435, 380, 427, 504, 506, 511, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused Akhilesh Kumar has been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail. The case of the petitioner is on better footing.

Taking into consideration, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and in the event of arrest, he shall be released on bail subject to conditions as laid down under section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C., which are as under:-

1. The petitioner, namely, VIMAL KUMAR shall



furnish personal bond with his recent self-attested photograph and surety of the like amount on the following conditions at the satisfaction of the investigating officer.

2. The petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available for interrogation whenever required.

3. The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any witness acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer,

4. The petitioner shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;

5. The petitioner shall not leave the territory of Sitamarhi without prior permission of the court, till trial is over;

6. The petitioner shall maintain law and order;

7. The petitioner shall, at the time of execution of the bond, furnish his address and mobile number to the investigating officer, and the court concerned, and shall not change the residence till the final disposal of the case;

8. The petitioner shall surrender his passport, if any, before the investigating officer within a week and, if he does not possess any passport, he shall file an affidavit to that effect



before the investigating officer;

9. The petitioner shall regularly remain present during the trial and cooperate with the Hon'ble court to complete the trial for the above offences.
