2 08-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Risiup P.S. Case No. 56 of 2021 registered under Sections 420 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code and 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that petitioner has no concern with the alleged pickup vehicle and the illicit liquor. Petitioner is neither the owner nor the driver of the alleged pickup vehicle. Further he submits that petitioner is a man of clean antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Additional District and Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Aurangabad in connection with Risiup P.S. Case No. 56 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
