ORAL ORDER

2 11-05-2022 Permission is granted to learned counsel for the petitioner to make necessary correction in the prayer portion of the bail petition.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Biraul P.S. Case No. 376 of 2020 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. There is case and counter case between the parties. Further submission is that both the parties have sustained injuries in the alleged occurrence.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Biraul, Darbhanga in connection with Biraul P.S. Case No. 376 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
