The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Sasaram (T) P.S. Case No. 291 of 2021 registered for offences under Sections 363 and 367 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are father and sister of the main accused, who has eloped with the alleged victim.

Considering the aforesaid facts and also Annexure-2, which is the petition filed by the informant in the Court below, this anticipatory bail application is allowed.



Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Sasaram (T) P.S. Case No. 291 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
