That this writ application is being filed
for quashing the letter dated 01.04.2022
issued by authorized officer of Punjab
National Bank (Respondent No.3) wherein in
reply to letter dated 16.03.2022 where by



no dues certificate and return of original document was demanded by the petitioner No.1 in view of High court order dated 14.2.2022 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 524 of 2022 (M/S Raj Traders & others vs. The Zonal Manager Punjab National Bank and others.) after depositing due amount Rs. 30,85,000 (30 Lacs 85 thousands) to which Respondent No.3 disagreed and demanded Rs.42,89,365.01 (Rs. Forty two Lakh eight nine thousand there hundred sixty five point one) (due amount Rs. 42, 24,,365.01+65,000 Legal expensed of auctioning secured property) as the amount required for settling the account. And for direction for issuance of no dues certificate and original document/documents ~~with~~ ^{with} kept the Bank.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition with better particulars, on the same and subsequent cause of action, in accordance with law, if so required and desired.

Permission granted with liberty, as prayed for.

Liberty also reserved to the petitioners to make a mention for listing of the petition on priority basis.

shall take steps for listing the petition at the earliest.
