2 01-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove
the defects within four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under Sections 379, 506 of the Indian
Penal Code.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He
has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in
the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation
levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and
omnibus in nature. The occurrence took place on 31.12.2019 but
the FIR was lodged on 04.01.2020, which creates a serious



doubt of genuineness of the case. Both the informant and petitioner are agnates. He further submits that both the parties have purchased the alleged motor combined, and due to some dispute of water logging, the informant has lodged a false case and implicated the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Mehsi P.S. Case No.04 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
