2 01-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove
the defects within four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under sections 411, 413, 414, 420,
467, 468/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the petitioner along with his other associates is
said to have stolen motorcycles. Four motorcycles were also
seized by the police party.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He
has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty politics. No
such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place.



His name is transpired in this case on the basis of the confessional statement of co-accused. The allegation leveled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is no recovery from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since his name has been disclosed by the apprehended co-accused, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner named above on bail. The prayer for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner is rejected.

This instant application is dismissed.
