2 04-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through virtual court proceeding.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of
non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will
place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a)/37(b)
(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

From perusal of the impugned order, it appears that



petitioner is involved in another cases apart from present one.

Considering the facts that the petitioner has suppressed the criminal antecedent, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected in connection with Patliputra P.S. Case No. 223 of 2021.
