2 06-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a woman having clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 39 liters liquor from a plastic sack kept in a yellow color school van which was found near the poultry farm of Vicky Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from her conscious possession and she came to be implicated as she is owner of the alleged van which was



found near the poultry farm of Vicky Kumar, it is further submitted that she was completely unaware that the driver of the vehicle would misuse the vehicle for such an illegal purpose.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Fatuha P.S. Case No. 390 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
