2 05-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 27 litres and 108.35 of country liquor was recovered on a raid being conducted from the house of Ashish Mandal and the petitioner who was hiding himself there was taken into custody.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that even from the FIR, no incriminating article has been recovered from his possession He is in custody since 28.8.2021 and has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and



taking into consideration the facts of the case specially the petitioner not having any criminal antecedent, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Sabour P.S. Case no. 220 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge II – cum – Special Judge, Excise, Bhagalpur.
