2 13-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 504 and 506/34 of the IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

It is a case of open fire in the air and abused to the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and there is general and omnibus allegation against him. Neither anybody was hit nor anyone got injured by opening the fire by accused persons.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-IV, Nawada in connection with Kauwakol P.S. Case No. 391 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
