2 13-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution story in nutshell is that Tulsi Thakur having fraudulently acquired title of land by getting a sale deed in his favour and also getting the mutation done in his favour and thereafter, having fraudulently taken the compensation amount from the Government. The allegation against petitioner is that



petitioner being circle officer have created Jamabandi and issued LPC on the basis of forged and fabricated sale deeds.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner has no concern with compassion amount or any sale deed. He is only signatory authority in capacity of circle officer of Sagauli Anchal. It is also submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the Halaka Karamchari and purchasers and other co-accused persons (similarly situated co-accused persons) have been granted anticipatory bail in this case by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four



weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands)
with two sureties of the like amount each to the
satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Motihari, East Champaran
in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 222 of 2019,
subject to the conditions as laid down under Section
438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
