2 15-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, as pointed out by the office
be removed within four weeks.

In the present case, the petitioner seeks bail in
connection with Barhara P.S. Case No. 506 of 2022 registered
for the alleged offences under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

Allegedly, 250 liters of country made Mahua liquor
was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the
petitioner was apprehended from the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from his



conscious possession. The petitioner has no concern with the recovered articles. The charge sheet has been submitted in this case and the petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2022. The petitioner is having clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail made on behalf of the petitioner.

Having regard to the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner and considering the submission of charge sheet and the period of custody of the petitioner along with his clean antecedent, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Exclusive Special Excise Court No.1, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Barhara P.S. Case No. 506 of 2022, subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 437 (3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and also the following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner.
- (ii) The petitioner will remain present on each and every date fixed by the court below.
- (iii) In case of absence on three consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail,



the bail bond of the petitioner will be liable to
be cancelled by the court concerned.
