Petitioners have prayed for the following relief(s):-

“For directing the respondents authorities to consider the proposal of petitioners under OTS scheme so that the petitioners may pay the entire amount of loan to the respondent and further give direction to the respondent Bank to refund the sale deed of the property which is lying with the Bank after making settlements with the petitioners.”



After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take alternative and/or appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, before the appropriate forum/Tribunal, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn



with the liberty aforesaid.
