ORAL ORDER

2 15-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the Informant and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 366(A), 341, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of abduction of daughter of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the victim was recovered and her statement was recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. wherein she has



asserted that she solemnized marriage with co-accused Pramod Kumar Yadav and she has not whispered about the complicity of these petitioners in this case. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mrs. Preeti Ray, Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Araria/concerned Court in connection with Bhargama Police Station Case No.121 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
